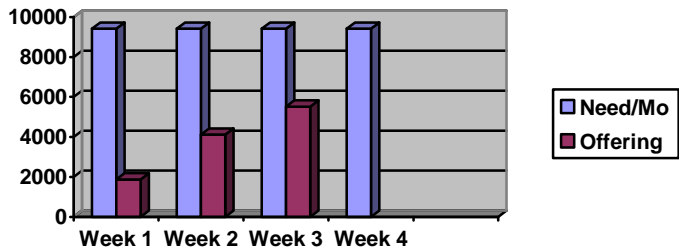

Church Budget February 2009

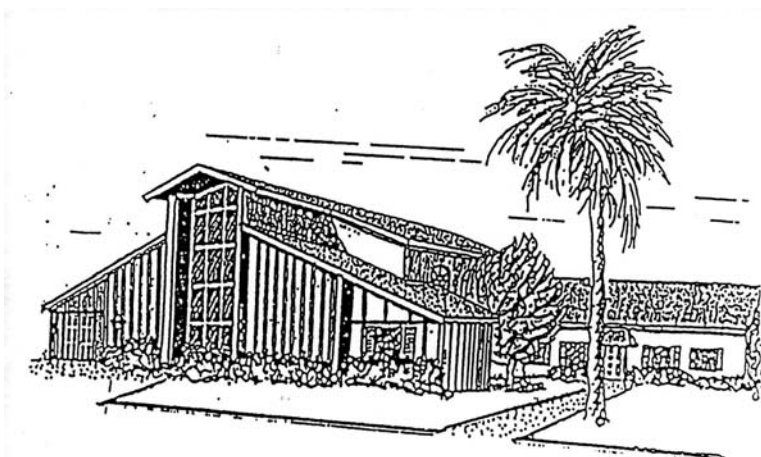
