THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the sanctuary today is a love offering to God from the Devadhason family in thankfulness for the tax season.

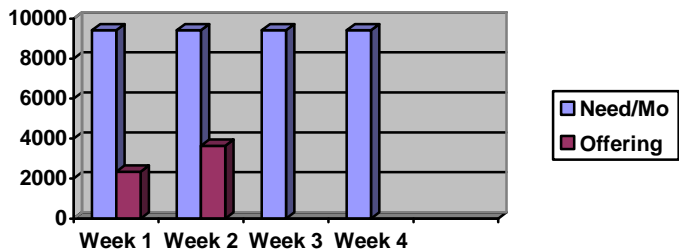

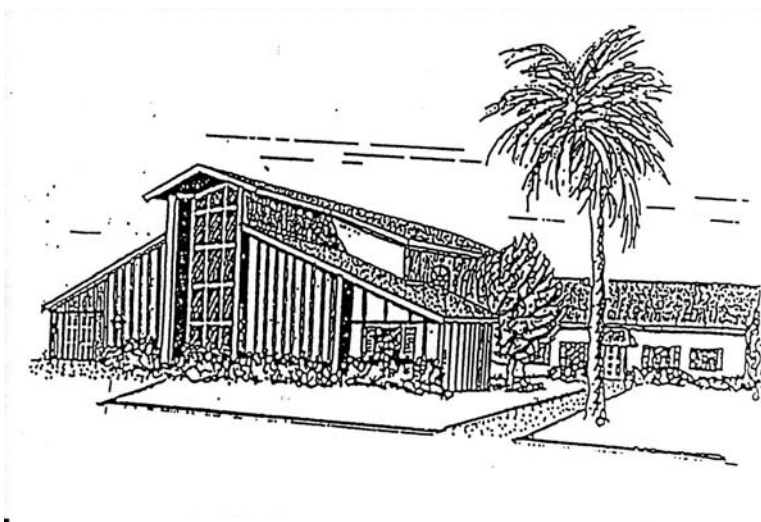
