SCRIPTURE

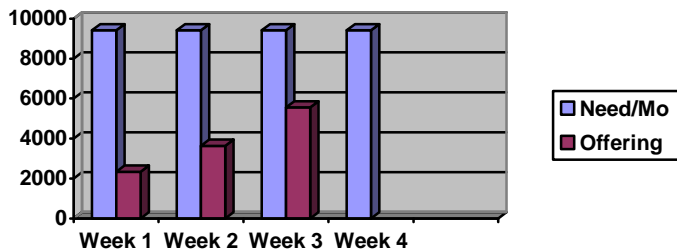

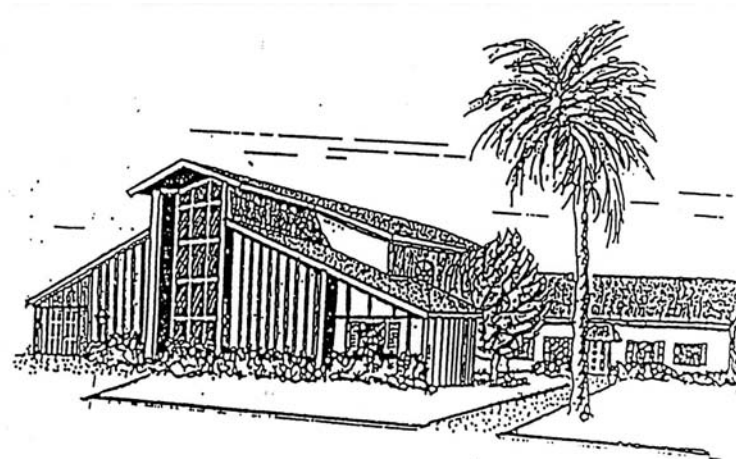
