THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the sanctuary today is a love offering to God from Maty Unruh in thankfulness for another birthday.

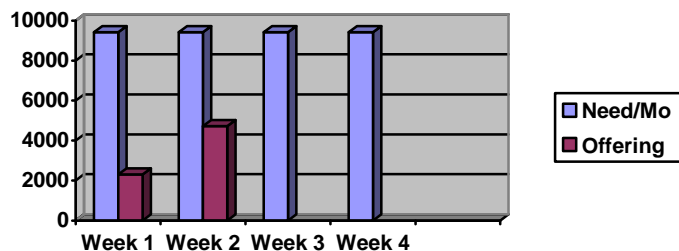

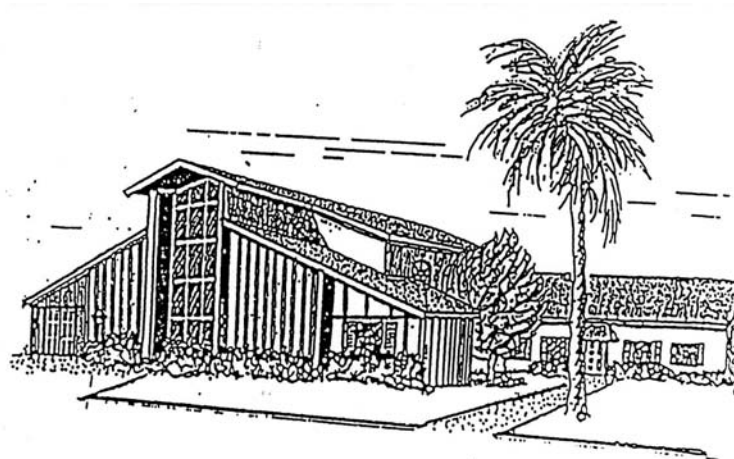
