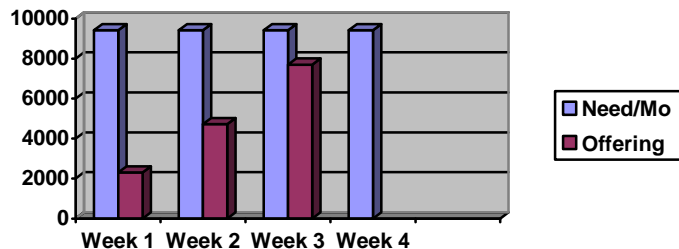

Church Budget June 2009

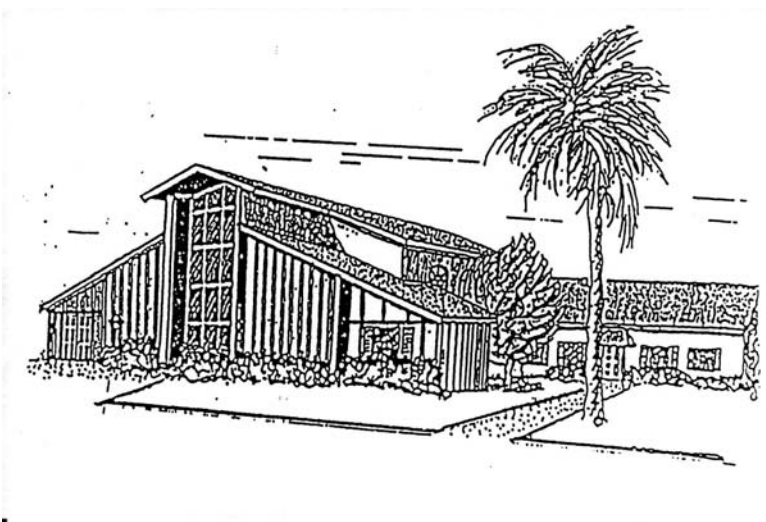
