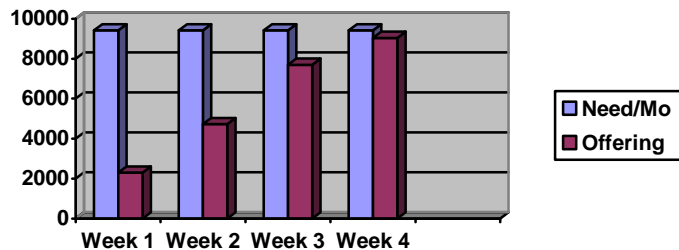
THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the sanctuary today is a love offering to God from Alex Stephens in celebration of Shirley's birthday.

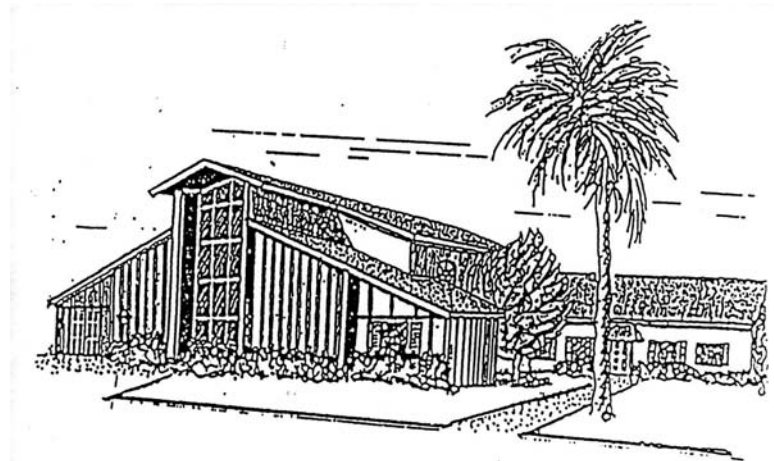
