THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the sanctuary today is a love offering to God from Eloise Daniels.

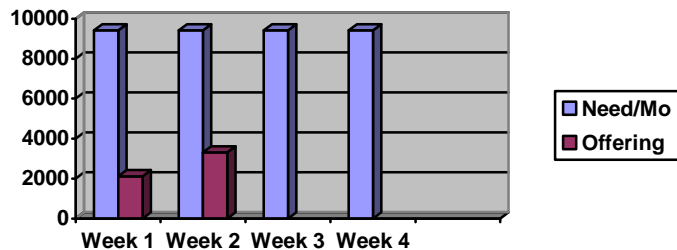
CALLING ALL YOUNG ADULTS A Sabbath School class just for you is meeting in Will Penick's office during Sabbath School class time.

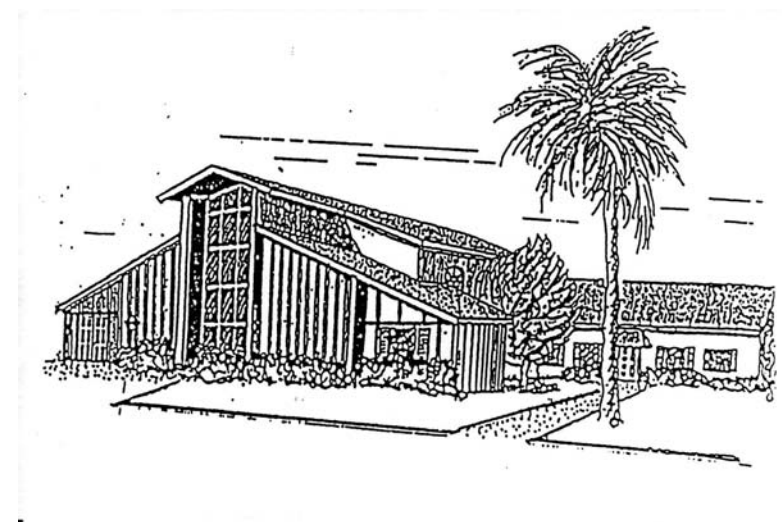
