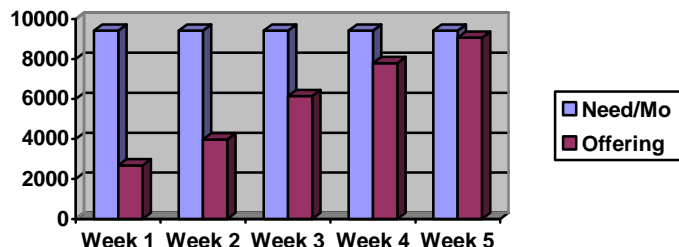
ANNOUNCEMENTS

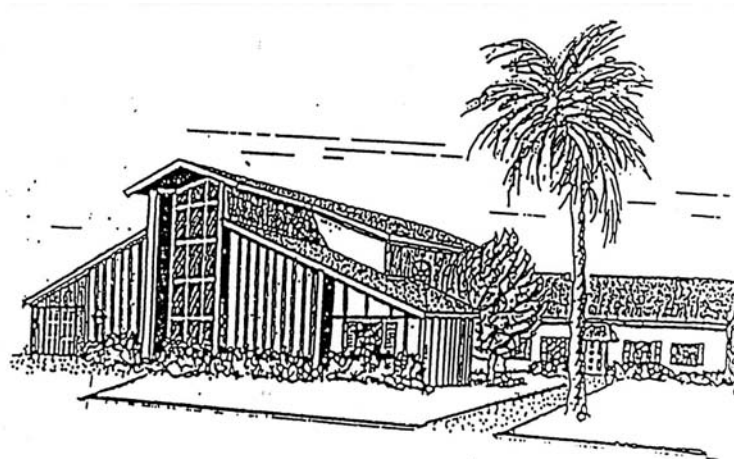
