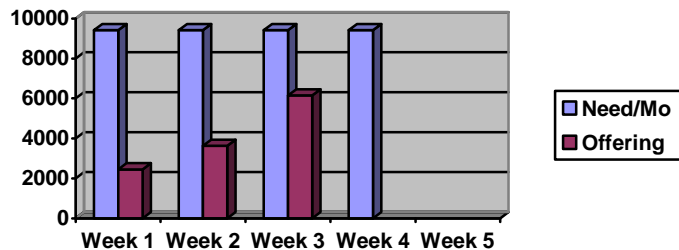
**THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT** in the sanctuary today is a love offering to God from the Devadhasons in celebration of Rajiv's birthday.

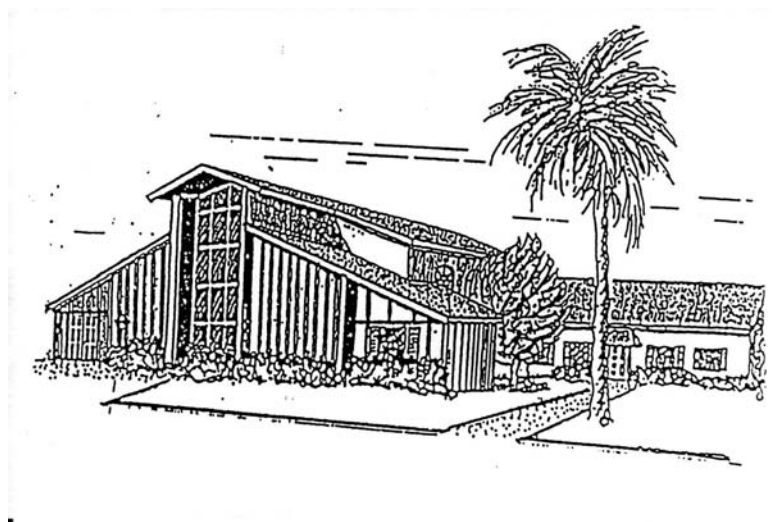
