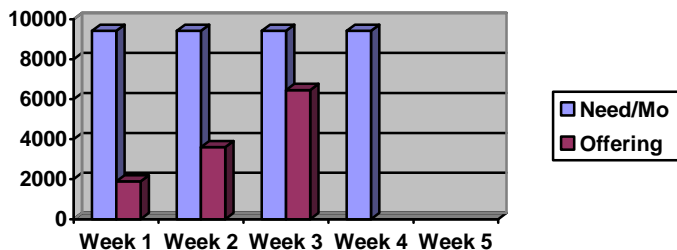
ANNOUNCEMENTS

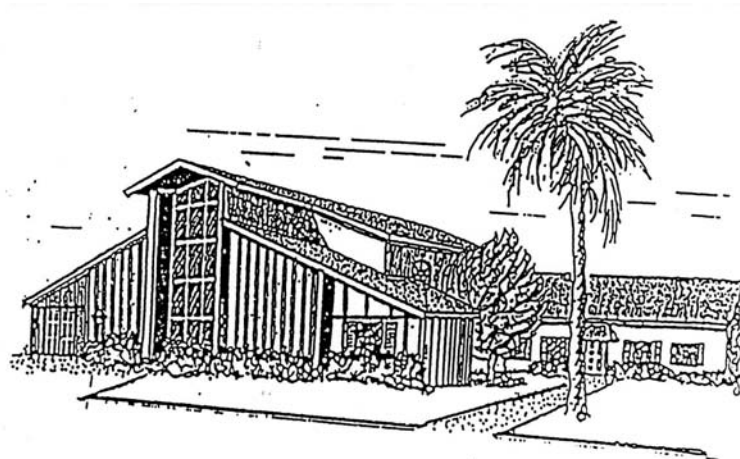
