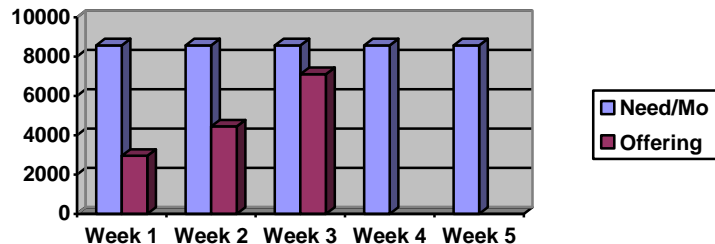
## ANNOUNCEMENTS

Church Budget December 2011



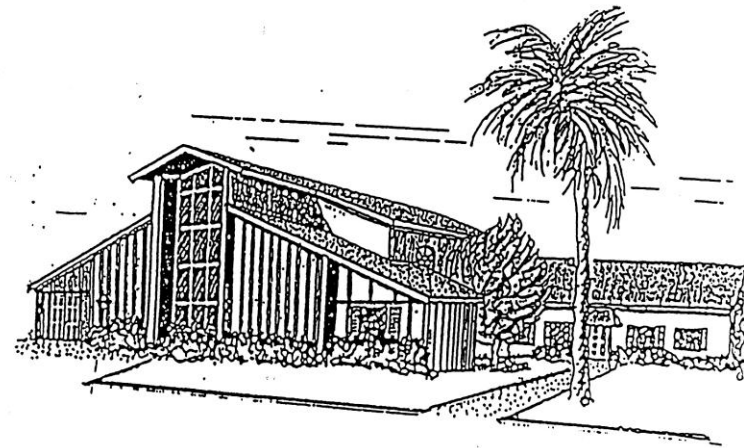
