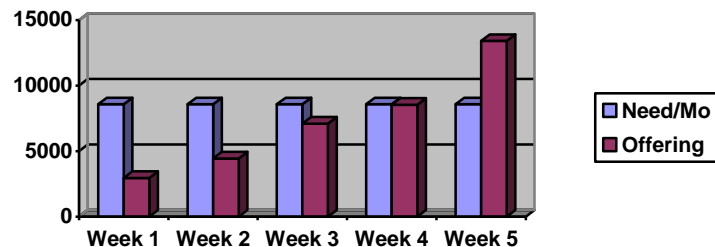

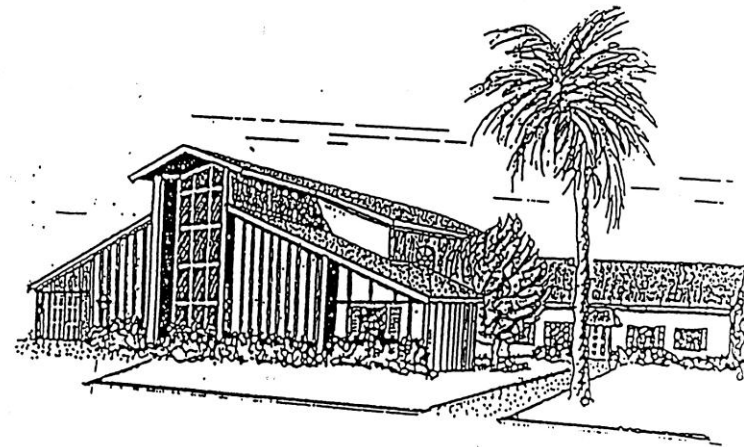

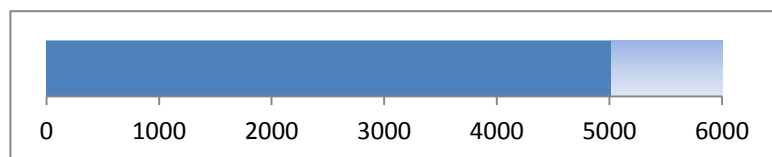
UNITED PRAYER Going forward the Thursday night United Prayer meeting will be determined by interest expressed at the poll at www.Hillis.us/prayer.
