THE FLORAL ARRANGMENT in the Sanctuary today is a love offering to God in loving memory of George Buben.

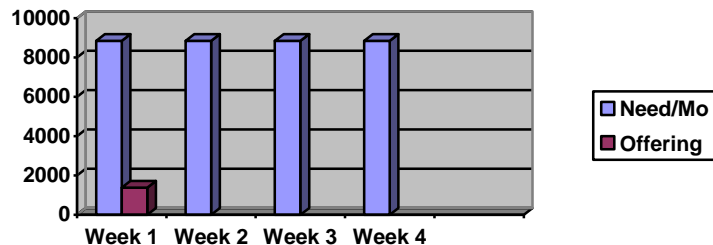

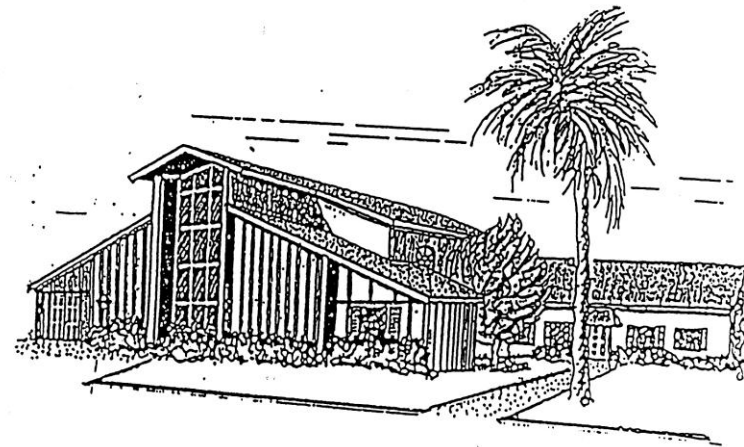

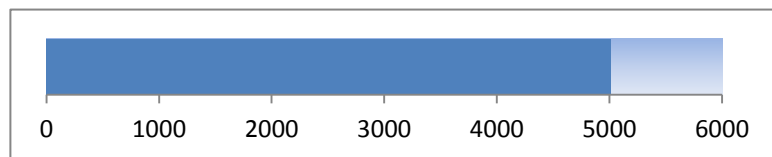
