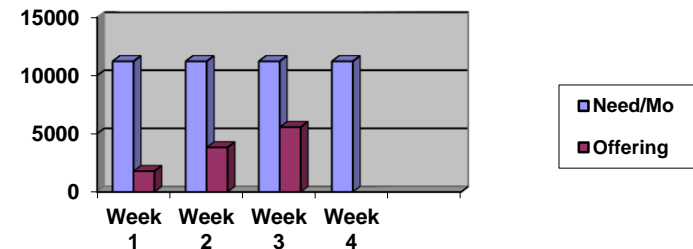

Get on CA-54 W in National City

- ↑ 1. Head north on 4th Ave toward D St 3 min (0.9 mi)
- ↑ 2. Continue onto Highland Ave 0.5 mi
- ⤴ 3. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left to merge onto CA-54 W 0.2 mi

Take Exit 1A and I-5 S to J St in Chula Vista. Take exit 7B from I-5 S

- ⤴ 4. Merge onto CA-54 W 3 min (2.9 mi)
- ⤴ 5. Use the left 2 lanes to take exit 1A to merge onto I-5 S 0.4 mi
- ⤴ 6. Take exit 7B toward Marina Pkwy 2.3 mi

Take Marina Pkwy and Bayshore Bikeway/Sandpiper Way to your destination
