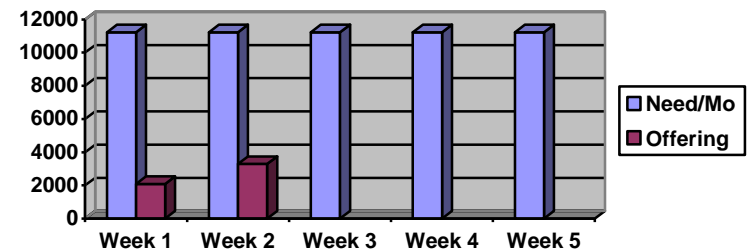

**\*NOM COM MEETING:** Tomorrow, Oct. 18, 2015 at 9:00 AM. All on committee are urged to attend meeting.

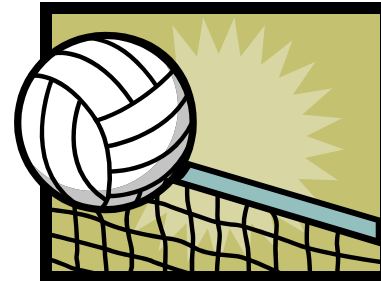
