

All volunteers must sign an acknowledgement form.

Volunteers level 1&2 must Sign and submit SECC Volunteer

Acknowledgement Form. Form is attached or can be accessed at link below.

What to complete:

- o (volunteer level 1) Training in Mandatory Reporting
- o (volunteer level 2) Live Scan Fingerprinted Background Check
- Any volunteer with driving as part of their duties, a DMV check/clearance is required

Child Abuse & Neglect Identification & Mandated Reporting

- Where To Get the Training
 - <u>Https://mandatedreporterca.com</u>
 - o upload the certificate of completion to VOLUNTEERS
- Must be done every two (2) years

Volunteer Level 2

- Complete the <u>"Request for Live Scan Service" Form</u>
- Once Request for Livescan Service form is completed, Google location of "Livescan" business closest to where you live, go get your fingerprinting process done.
- Pay for Livescan, obtain receipt and submit to church for Reimbursement
- Livescan is done only one time for volunteer level 2
